



2027 ACDC SCHOLARSHIP

ACDC's annual scholarship program was created to help graduating Atchison County high school seniors fund post-secondary education and training programs, especially those that can help students contribute to the future of Atchison County.

ACDC scholarship program offers a \$1,000* scholarship in each of the following categories, for a total of two scholarships** per school district area:

- Tech school training program/community college degree (welding certification, CNA training, lineman school, etc.)
- 4-year undergraduate degree program

** The ACDC scholarship is sent directly to the education institution in two \$500 checks (typically in August and December), after confirmation of enrollment.*

*** Changing from one type of program/school to the other after scholarships have been awarded may impact a student's scholarship eligibility, due to ACDC's desire to award one in each category per school.*

Application procedure:

Applicants must complete the attached scholarship application and indicate which of the two post-secondary routes they will be pursuing. Basic information is required on the application form (academic information, activities, awards, etc.), as well as a brief essay response to the following prompt:

Tell us what you have loved about growing up in Atchison County or give an example of how growing up in Atchison County helped you become who you are today.
